

Welcome to Quito, the capital of Ecuador Meet your colleagues and settle in for dinner



Enjoy the picturesque drive known for its waterfalls and birdwatching before arriving in the Arlequín Reserve in the Mindo cloudforest. Set up your BioBlitz stations and spend the evening briefing about the project



Daytime activities include visiting trap stations, diurnal surveys along transects, and scientific white background photography. Nighttime activities include photography of insects in light traps, herpetological visual encounter surveys, and examination of mist nets to record bat species



Travel across the high Andes of Ecuador to the Pitalala Reserve in the upper Amazon rainforest of Ecuador. Set up the next set of Bio Blitz stations and begin monitoring this night



You will spend four nights immersed in the rainforest of Pitalala Reserve building up the species lists of reptiles, amphibians, mammals, birds, beetles, moths, butterflies, and aquatic invertebrates.

At the end of each sampling day, the team will gather to annotate the recorded species on a whiteboard

Enjoy a last breakfast with the team before heading back to Quito to depart













Trip Details

Enjoy three delicious meals each day, with complimentary tea, coffee, and juice included. Accommodations are in a beautiful eco lodge camp at the edge of a cliff in the Pitalala Reserve and a rustic cabin in the cloudforest of the Arlequín Reserve. Featuring comfortable twin-share rooms, western toilet and hot water showers, with all bedding and towels provided. While in Quito, relax in twin-share hostel-style rooms for a restful experience. Please note that alcohol and snacks are not included.
