For Wilde Tracks, Imany is a symbol of strength and hope, and soon her inspiring story will become a cherished part of our journey.

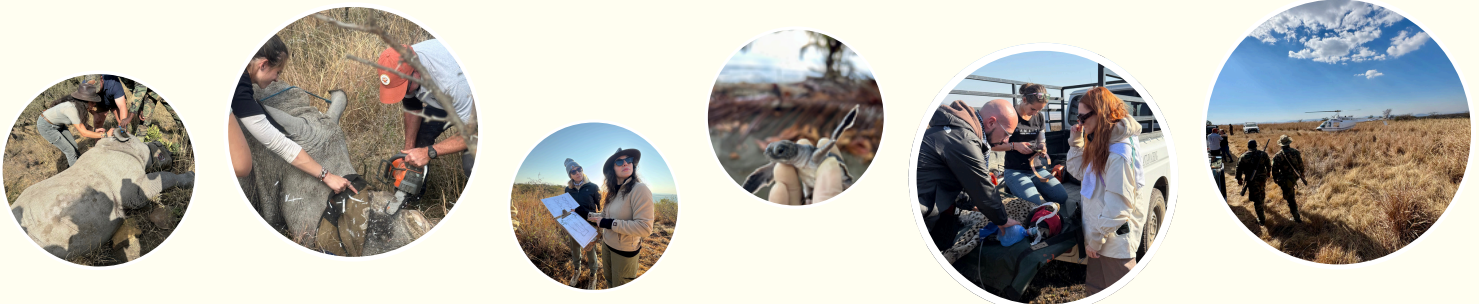
Conservation Mission - July 2025

Trip Highlights:

- **1 Cheetah Collared** – For vital monitoring and data collection, supporting ongoing research and human-wildlife conflict management.
- **2 White Rhinos & 1 Black Rhino Dehorned** – A crucial anti-poaching measure that helps protect these endangered species from illegal wildlife trade.

Every collar fitted and every horn safely removed represents a step forward in preserving Africa's iconic wildlife. A heartfelt thank you to everyone who made this mission possible — your impact is real, lasting, and deeply appreciated.

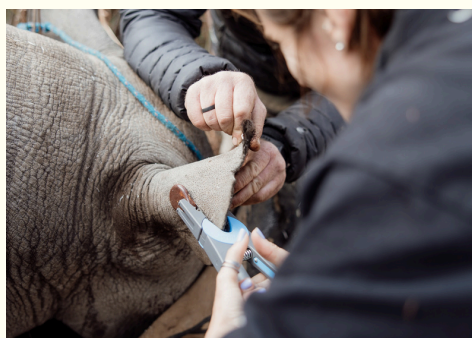

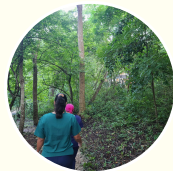
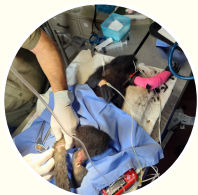
