Conservation in Action

We operate across key conservation regions in Africa and Central America, where wildlife faces growing threats from human-wildlife conflict, habitat fragmentation, harmful superstitions, the illegal wildlife trade, and the exotic pet market.

In Africa, our work spans South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda, Namibia and Malawi, focusing on protecting vulnerable species and restoring ecosystems under pressure while empowering local communities on the importance of preserving the ecosystem.

In Central and South America, we support vital conservation efforts in Costa Rica, Guatemala, Ecuador, The Galapagos and Belize, areas rich in unique wildlife and natural heritage.

These regions urgently need support to address the complex challenges threatening both animals and the environments they depend on.

We work alongside a diverse network of professionals—wildlife veterinarians, rehabilitation specialists, marine biologists, ecologists, and wildlife forensics experts—to deliver targeted, impactful solutions. There is also the opportunity for longer internships and specific research partnerships for those looking to contribute more deeply to our work.

Each year, we grow our reach, forming new partnerships and helping more species recover and thrive in the wild.

Embark on a truly unique conservation journey—of the crocodilian kind! Join the Crocodile Research course and gain hands-on experience working with crocodiles, primates, and a variety of Belize's incredible wildlife while exploring the country's rich and diverse ecosystems. Whether you choose our 2-week or 1-month program, you'll take part in real-world fieldwork including crocodile population surveys (by day and night), nest monitoring, biodiversity assessments around lagoons and mangroves, and even mangrove restoration projects as part of the Belize Mangrove Alliance. For those in the month-long course, you may be involved with further wildlife monitoring such as primate surveys—tracking howler and spider monkeys, some of whom were rescued from the illegal pet trade. You'll assist with animal husbandry and behavioral studies of our crocodile ambassadors, participate in environmental education events with local communities, and learn how to turn science into action through expert-led presentations on research methods, ecology, parasitology, genetics, and more. Ideal for aspiring scientists, conservationists, and anyone passionate about wildlife, this course offers unmatched field experience, one-on-one mentorship, and the chance to contribute meaningfully to wildlife conservation. Join us in Belize and help protect some of the world's most misunderstood—and most important—species, one croc (and community) at a time!

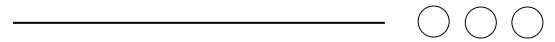

At Wildlife Tracks, we believe everyone has the power to make a meaningful impact in conservation.

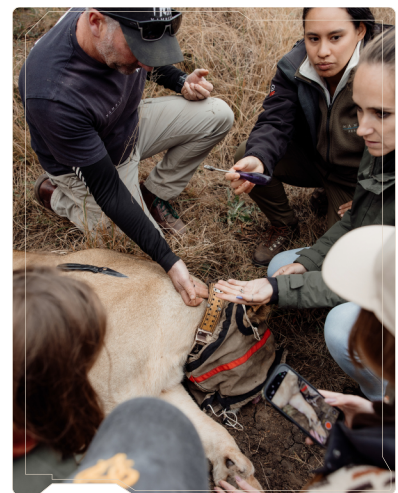
When you join one of our missions, you're not just going on an adventure — you're becoming part of a real, boots-on-the-ground conservation effort. Your conservation contribution directly funds:
