In Africa, our work spans South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda, Namibia and Malawi, focusing on protecting vulnerable species and restoring ecosystems under pressure hile empowering local communities on the importance of preserving the ecosystem.


In Central and South America, we support vital conservation efforts in Costa Rica, Guatemala, Ecuador, The Galapagos and Belize, areas rich in unique wildlife and natural heritage.

These regions urgently need support to address the complex challenges threatening both animals and the environments they depend on.

We work alongside a diverse network of professionals—wildlife veterinarians, rehabilitation specialists, marine biologists, ecologists, and wildlife forensics experts—to deliver targeted, impactful solutions. There is also the opportunity for longer internships and specific research partnerships for those looking to contribute more deeply to our work.

Gain a solid understanding of the legal side of conservation through practical training in drafting statements, preparing evidence, and delivering testimony in a simulated moot court. Complement your forensic skills with real-world field experience, including dart gun use, animal handling, anti-poaching tactics, and tracking wildlife in game reserves. Designed for those passionate about protecting endangered species, this program offers a rare opportunity to train alongside professionals on the front lines of wildlife conservation and law enforcement.
