Conservation in Action

We operate across key conservation regions in Africa and Central America, where wildlife faces growing threats from human-wildlife conflict, habitat fragmentation, harmful superstitions, the illegal wildlife trade, and the exotic pet market.

In Africa, our work spans South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda, Namibia and Malawi, focusing on protecting vulnerable species and restoring ecosystems under pressure while empowering local communities on the importance of preserving the ecosystem.

In Central and South America, we support vital conservation efforts in Costa Rica, Guatemala, Ecuador, The Galapagos and Belize, areas rich in unique wildlife and natural heritage.

These regions urgently need support to address the complex challenges threatening both animals and the environments they depend on.

We work alongside a diverse network of professionals—wildlife veterinarians, rehabilitation specialists, marine biologists, ecologists, and wildlife forensics experts—to deliver targeted, impactful solutions. There is also the opportunity for longer internships and specific research partnerships for those looking to contribute more deeply to our work.

Each year, we grow our reach, forming new partnerships and helping more species recover and thrive in the wild.

From annual health checks and rescue intakes to suture work, sample analysis, and patient monitoring, you'll be immersed in real-world veterinary care. Expand your skills further by assisting in domestic animal outreach through the LSCPA—treating livestock, taking part in spay and neuter programs, and supporting rural communities. Deepen your knowledge through expert-led lectures on wildlife health, including parasitology, primate medicine, emergency care, pharmacology, and remote capture techniques. Between fieldwork, unwind at the sanctuary with full-board accommodation, surrounded by the sights and sounds of the animals you're helping. Cap off your adventure with a thrilling 2-day/1-night safari through the spectacular Liwonde National Park. This is more than just volunteering—it's conservation, education, and adventure rolled into one unforgettable journey.

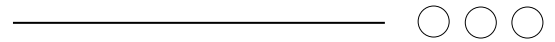
